

Alupka and the Vorontsov Palace

Visit main historical sight of Alupka - famous Vorontsov Palace. It was built for Prince Mikhail Semyonovich Vorontsov in 19th century. Enjoy beautiful park which surrounds The Palace. You will be astonished by tree-manifold, charming small waterfalls and famous lake with majestic swans in it.

Duration: 3 h.



Livadia

A major historical sight of Livadia is the Livadia Palace. It was a summer residence of the last Russian emperor Nicholas II. Famous Crimea Conference was held there among the Big Three (Britain, United States, and Soviet Union). There the most important decisions were taken about Second World war ending and world's post-war reorganization.

Duration: 2 h.



The palace of Alexander III

The palace of Russian Emperor Alexander III is one of the greatest architectural monuments on the Southern Coast of Crimea. This palace wins admiration of all its visitors. It was built in solitude near the mountain ridge, with luxuriant vegetation surroundings

Duration: 3 h.



Swallow's Nest Castle. Yalta in the evening

On top of 40-metres high Aurora Cliff of the Cape Ai Todor there is a tiny palace built to a Neo-Gothic design - the Swallow's Nest Castle. After visiting the Castle you will take a half-hour boat trip and admire Miskhor and Yalta from the pleasure-boat board.

Duration: 3 h.



Foros

The Church of Christ's Resurrection was built above the village of Foros on the lonely cliff. The church was commissioned for a tea trader from Moscow Alexander Kuznetsov by the project of architect Tchagin to commemorate Alexander III's survival in the train disaster.

Duration: 4 h.



The Nikitsky Botanical Garden

The Nikitsky Botanical Garden was founded by Russian botanist Christian Steven on the instructions of the Russian Emperor Alexander I in 1812. Its collection counts over 28,000 species, sorts and hybrides of plants from all over the world.

Duration: 3 h.



The Golden Ring of Crimea

This tour joins several popular routes. You will visit The Foros Church of Christ's Resurrection which was built in 1892 to commemorate Alexander III survival, the medieval Eski Kermen castle city and the Grand Canyon of Crimea where you can bathe in the Blue Lake.

Duration: 9 h.
