

Ay-Petri

Ay-Petri Mountain (1234 m) is the most popular peak in the South Coast of Crimea. Ay-Petri is an ancient coral reef raised from a sea bottom millions years ago. During this tour you will visit the Uchan-Su waterfall, make a stop near the Silver Arbor and rise on the Ay-Petri peak where you will have some free time.

Duration: 5 h.

Take convenient footwear with you.



Botkin path

“Botkin path means beauty and health!” – within this inscription you’ll start walking along popular path on the Stavri-Kaya cliff. This way was laid by enthusiasts of Crimean-Caucasian Mountain Club in 1901-1902. Enjoy pine-tree forest, curative air and magnificent views during all the tour.

Duration: 4 h.

Take convenient footwear with you.



Valley of the ghosts

Demerdzhi Mountain is always beautiful in the light of a morning dawn, in the midday heat and in declaim beams. The route of our tour goes by the Funa fortress ruins, the stone collapse and Partkun spring. Also you will visit **the Djurdjur waterfall**. Enjoy outstanding views and don’t forget to take camera with you!

Duration: 8 h.

Chatyr-Dag caves

The tour program includes visiting of two famous Crimean caves located at the lower plateau of Chatyr-Dag near the Simferopol city – the Marble Cave and an the Emine Bair Hosar cave.

The Grand Canyon of Crimea

This nature's miracle located in the depth of a northern slope of Ai-Petri massif. The Grand Canyon of Crimea belongs to the most considerable and valuable landscape sights of Crimean peninsula. During this tour you will have an opportunity to bathe in the famous Bath of Youth.

Duration: 7 h.

Take convenient footwear and swimming accessories with you.



Crimean national preserve

Crimean national preserve was founded in 1923 on a basis of the Russian imperial family's hunting land tightly guarded since 1870. During this tour you will visit a trout farm, the acting Kosmo-Demyanovsky monastery and rise to 1400m height to the Arbor of the Winds. There you will enjoy unforgettable view of the Southern Coast of Crimea. Also you will make a stop on the Red Stone cordon.

Duration: 7 h.

Take warm clothing, dry food ration and empty bottle for water with you.



The Golden Ring of Crimea

This tour joins some popular routes. You will visit The Foros Church of Christ's Resurrection which was built in 1892 to commemorate Alexander III's survival, the medieval Eski Kermen castle city and the Grand Canyon of Crimea where you can bathe in the Blue Lake.

Duration: 9 h.
